Jeb and Jock Guthrie, the Guthrie Brothers, headed east from their home state of Wisconsin after being bitten by the music bug. The brothers were born a year apart into a tightly-knit Midwestern family with three sisters. Growing up in Brillion, Wisconsin, a tiny farming community in the Fox River Valley, they sang together at school and church gatherings and family get-togethers. First stop in their travels was upstate New York, where they honed their craft in the club scene, and later relocated to New York City.

After a few years as an active, high-profile presence in the New York City original-music scene, the Guthries were signed to Next Horizon records, a Nashville-based indie start-up. Their CD, *The Guthrie Brothers*, was released nationally in June of 1996. Though their record label would close its doors by the end of 1996, the Guthrie Brothers continued to write, record and perform. Their album was recently re-released and *The Guthrie Brothers* is now available at iTunes, Napster and Rhapsody.

Touring in support of the CD and the single, *The Eyes of My Dad*, included warm-ups with country headliners John Berry and Bryan White, club, festival and college appearances throughout the United States, numerous on-air radio performances, and a featured appearance on the Nashville Network (TNN) Prime Time Country television show. Calling the Guthrie Brothers a "fresh acoustic duo", *Billboard Magazine* had this to say about the album: "Many stations will find the well-written, heartfelt lyrics and wonderful harmonies a welcome addition to their airwaves."

The Guthries' music has evolved from the country rock flavor of their first record to a more eclectic mix that leans toward rock, folk, and pop. Their songs have been recorded by other artists and featured in a number of movie and television soundtracks. Today, Jeb and Jock create music not bound by conventional radio formats that sizzles with stellar harmonies, soaring melodies and inspired guitar.
